Dear Parents and Carers,

We would say that **at least one Stay and Play** for the children to meet their teacher/some of their class and the information evening on **Monday 17**th **June** are the **priority if possible**. Please return the transition paperwork also attached to this email by 3.30pm on Friday 28th June.

As part of our process of smooth transition for your child, we aim to meet with as many **pre-school** settings as we can and will liaise with all pre-school settings to ensure all pertinent information is passed to us in advance, enabling your child to begin here at St Chad's with the best possible start. This process is made more straightforward if you let us know which pre-school your child has attended so that we can make the appropriate contact.

Uniform

There will be a need to order uniform ready for September and you may wish to consider ordering sooner rather than later as it can take a while.
