KEY IMPROVEMENTS

-  Separate cycle lanes and footpaths – improving safety for both pedestrians and cyclists.
-  Improved bus stops – with shelters and better crossings for easier access.
-  Additional priority bus lane – minimising delays for buses.
-  Pedestrian crossings – easier movement for pedestrians and wheelchair users.

Our programme of work, starting this spring and due to complete by the end of 2026, will make it easier and safer for people walking, cycling, wheeling, and make journeys quicker and more convenient when travelling by bus from Bradley Stoke and the surrounding area towards Aztec West and Bristol.

We recognise that these works will impact users of Bradley Stoke Way and other routes.

We are committed to minimising disruption and delays during construction, while ensuring the safety of the public and our workforce around work sites.
