Re: RSHE lessons/meeting

Dear Parents/Carers,

We are writing to let you know that we will be teaching RSHE (Relationships, Sex and Health Education) this term in Year 4. We are planning to teach this **Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> and Friday 4<sup>th</sup> July.** 

Through the teaching of the Jigsaw scheme of learning, alongside the school's RHSE policy, and in line with the Governments Relationship and Sex education curriculum, the **year 4** coverage will focus on:

- Understanding some personal characteristics come from birth parents
- How offspring grow and change into an adult
- Puberty
- Periods
- Labelling external parts of the male and female bodies

It will be taught using age appropriate diagrams, animations and vocabulary and the pupils will have an opportunity to ask their own questions within gender groups where appropriate.
