Encouraging children to read for pleasure is a key part of their school journey and research shows that reading for pleasure plays a significant role in improving children's life chances and opportunities.

To support all children in South Gloucestershire to develop a love of reading and have free access to books, South Gloucestershire Libraries are working with all primary schools in South Gloucestershire to give every primary school aged child their own library card.

It's free to use the library, borrow books and come to activities. There are no charges for books returned late, lost or damaged on children's cards and you can still use the library.

In November / December your child will be given a library card at school for them to take home. The card is ready to be activated when you next visit the library, please ask a member of library staff to do this for you. If your child already has a library card, either keep hold of it and continue to enjoy using it or hand it in when you next visit the library, the choice is yours.
