This is an excellent opportunity for the children to learn about the many hazards and dangers that are found in the home and their immediate environment, develop their awareness of hazards and provide them with appropriate strategies in case of emergency. The learning that they will take from the trip will provide them with key skills that they will refer to for the rest of their lives. The school have attended the Lifeskills centre for many years and this trip always proves to be very popular with the children.
