Your amazing support helped us raise **£1508.36**



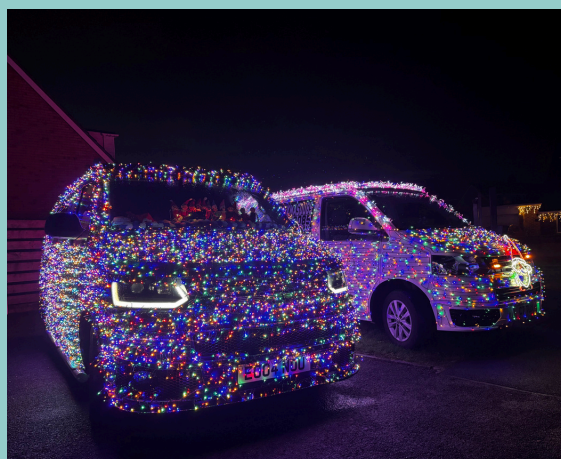
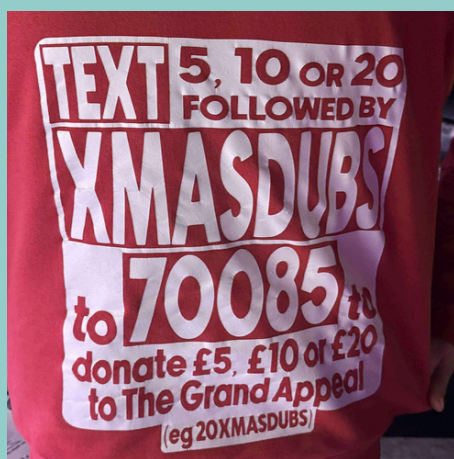


# Disco Magic

## Year 1 & 2 School Trip


