Training courses for parents and carers 2026

The Specialist Autism Support Service (SASS) commissioned by B&NES Local Authority provides training and support to parents and carers of autistic children and young people who live within B&NES. However, SASS have recently opened up some of our training courses to parents and carers who live outside of B&NES. The following training courses are now open to parents and carers of young people with a confirmed autism diagnosis who live outside B&NES at a cost of £20 per place. Wednesday, March 11th 9.30am to 12.30pm	Understanding girls and internal presentations of autism, including masking Led by Beci Burr and Jess Clark	This is a combined course for parents and professionals, which aims to develop an understanding of how to support autistic girls/autistic individuals with a more internalised presentation. This includes exploring how parents and carers can support at home, alongside how school-based professionals can support these individuals within their education settings. It is widely acknowledged that girls and women are often "missed" in terms of diagnosis, so this course will aim to explore and address some misconceptions around autistic females, as well as stereotyped ideas about what autism can look like across all genders, and the impact of masking.	£20 per place Online via Microsoft Teams
